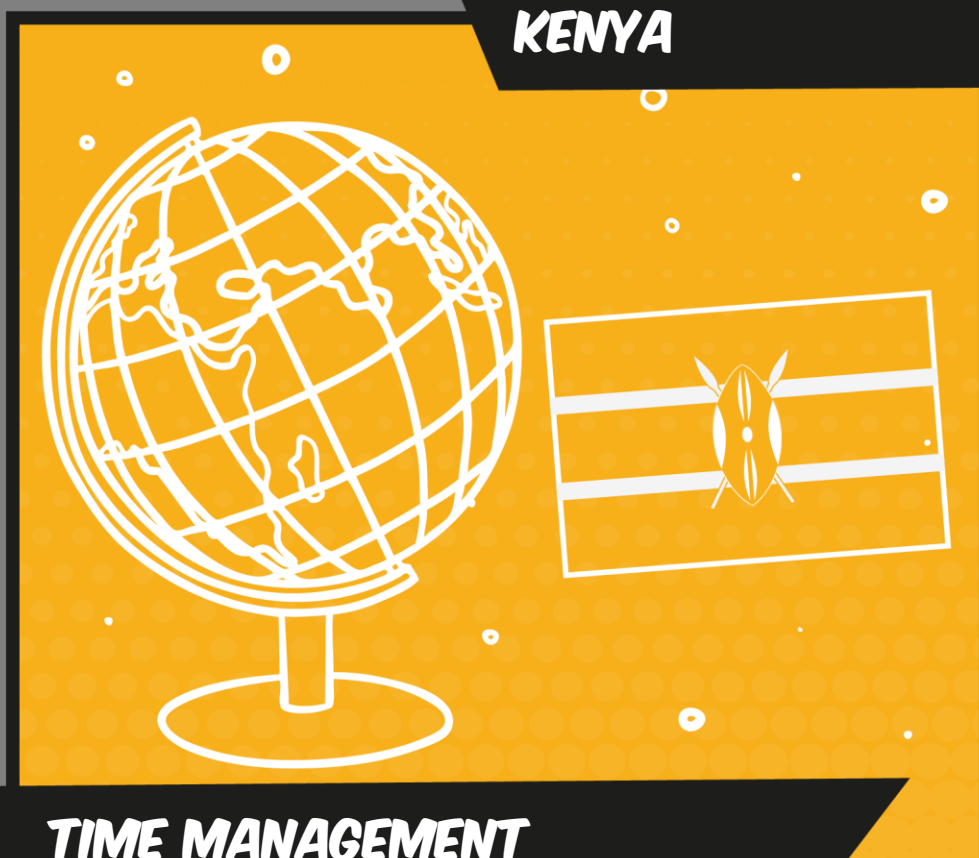
I train assistants on new tasks (e.g. data collection, transcriptions, coding) using a software called ELAN.
