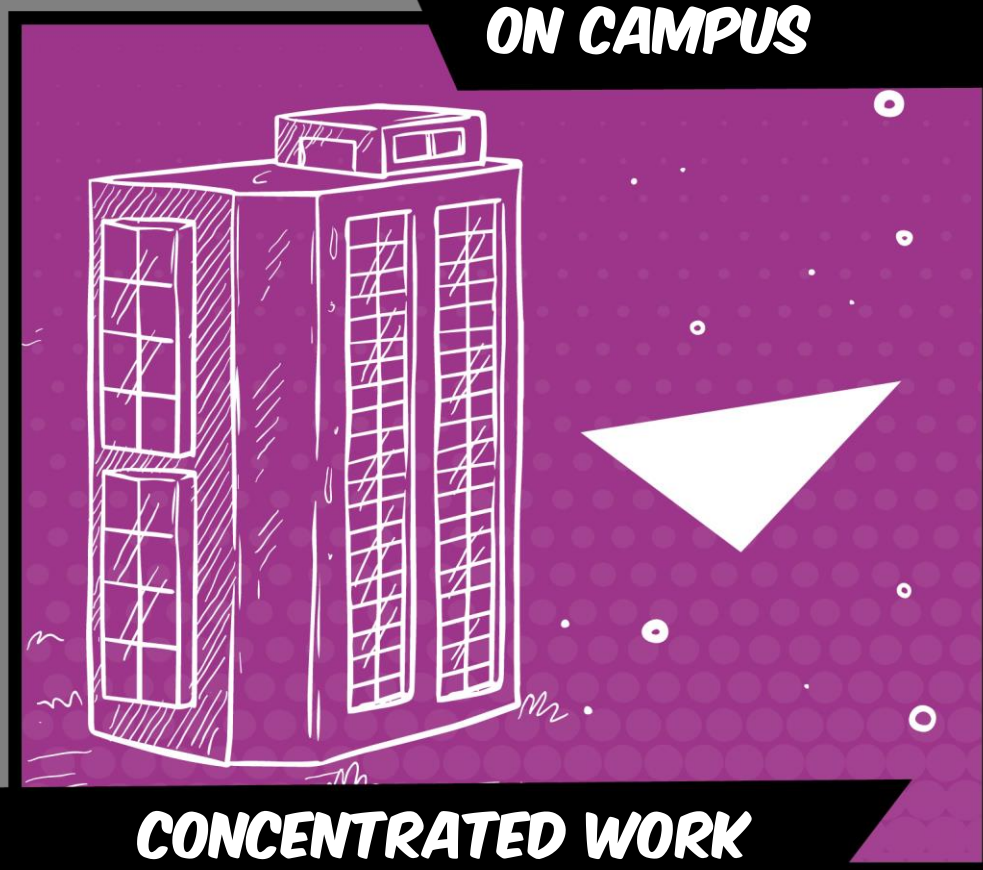
A Hybrid Worker:

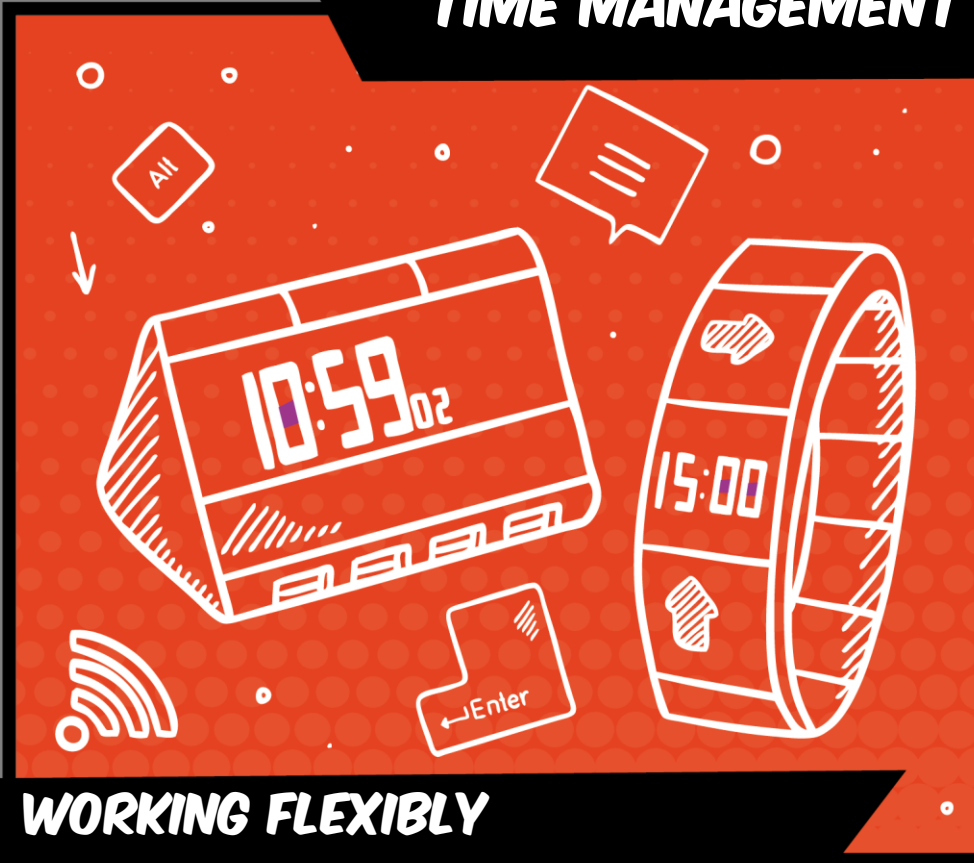
